Club Metropolitan – Association for Metropolitan Mobility (AMM), supported by UITP, AIDA, Alba Iulia City Hall, STP Alba Iulia and Oradea Metropolitan Area Association, organizes the fourth edition of the **Forum for Sustainable Mobility and Metropolitan Development**, on 8 and 9 April, in Alba Iulia. Representatives of national authorities, intercommunity development associations, public transport operators, ministries in charge with the organization of public transport and of the European financing acquisitions, of the industry and of the international organizations promoting sustainable mobility.

Over the past years, Romania has used an important part of European funds for public transport development, especially for infrastructure projects or intelligent transport systems. In the next programming period, 2014-2020, these investments are expected to continue, doubled by investments in the modernisation of the fleet of vehicles, based on new possibilities of using the same European funds for this purpose. Acquisitions of trams, trolleybuses or new EURO6 buses have already been announced or launched in several cities. To access European funds, the cities declared growth poles will be forced, for the first time in Romania, to develop sustainable mobility plans. The Romanian Ministry of Regional Development and Public Administration (MDRAP) and EBRD are currently carrying out a consultancy tender to implement these plans and public service obligations on public transport.

All these investments have to be integrated and closely related to urban development or to the development of the large national and European transport corridors. Cities and suburban communities, organised in intercommunity associations, have to think about an organised, metropolitan transport, in compliance with European regulations that would use all the transport modes existing in the urban area of influence. This project is already in progress in many cities, among which the host city, Alba Iulia, that has managed to successfully complete this mission.

The fourth edition of the Forum for Sustainable Mobility and Metropolitan Development organised by Club Metropolitan – Association for Metropolitan Mobility (AMM) is an opportunity to discuss the problems, but also the projects and opportunities in the Romanian area. The success of the previous editions, attended by a significant number of representatives of county councils, regional development agencies, municipalities and transport operators, next to representatives of MDRAP and the European Commission, JASPER, EIB, entitles us to hope to a significant attendance to this Forum organised in Alba Iulia.
